The Board of Education of Gibson City-Melvin-Sibley Community Unit School District #5 met in special session on Monday, August 19, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. in the GCMS Board Room for the purpose of approving the **FCSEC FY 2019-2020 Budget**. The board was called to order by Board President Josh Johnson, roll was called with members Whitehouse, Elder, Young, Friday, Tucker-Davis and Leonard in attendance. Also present were Elementary School Principal Justin Kean, Middle School Principal Kyle Bielfeldt, High School Principal Chris Garard, Curriculum Director Erin Nuss, FCSEC Director Jesse McFarling, Board Secretary Lori Kristensen and District Superintendent Jeremy Darnell.

Director McFarling presented to the board the **FCSEC Fiscal Year 2020 budget**. He reviewed the revenue and expenditures per fund and explained the majority of expense in the budget is from salaries. The budget estimates \$999,550 in revenue and \$1,031.350 in expenditures. McFarling added there are no changes to the budget from what the FCSEC Executive Board already approved.
